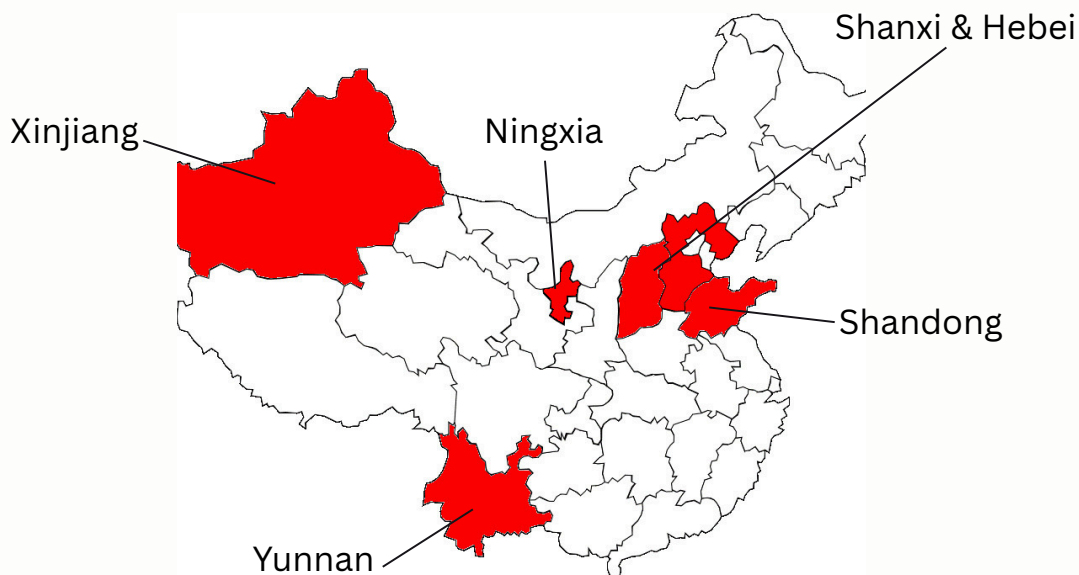

# INTRODUCTION

## Chinese Wines - A Journey Through Taste & Terroir

China's premium vineyards mirror the world's top wine regions, stretching across the "wine window" of 24°N to 47°N latitude. To the east, the coastal regions sit at 37°N alongside Napa Valley and Sicily. Inland & northern regions shift to 44°N, matching Bordeaux. In the southwest, China breaks traditional viticultural rules, where vineyards thrive at ultra-low, tropical latitudes (24°N) exclusively by ascending alpine slopes up to 2,800 metres above sea level, where cool mountain air successfully mimics European growing seasons.



China boasts a long history in winemaking, with the world's earliest fermented beverage crafted around 7,000 BC using wild native grapes, rice, and honey. Modern dry winemaking took roots in 1892 with China's first industrial estate (Changyu).

**Eastern**, coastal vineyards enjoy moderate winters but battle humid summer monsoons and rain during the harvest-season.

**Western** vineyards sit in complete mountain rain shadows, virtually eliminating fungal pressure and rely entirely on glacial river irrigation.

**Northern** vineyards endure harsh Siberian winters, requiring labor-intensive winter burial where vines are buried under soil to survive.

**Southern** mountain valleys are frost-free, defined by steep Himalayan topography that blocks tropical humidity to yield grapes with intense structural tannins.

## CHAPTER 1:

# SHANDONG

### Eastern Awakening - Coastal Freshness & Heritage Varietals

Shandong's premium wine culture thrives within the unique coastal, maritime macroclimate of the Shandong Peninsula. Influenced by the cool currents of the Yellow Sea, the region enjoys a long, tempered growing season that stands in stark contrast to the rest of mainland China.

Across its rolling hillsides, the vineyard geology features highly desirable, well-drained and mineral-rich soils, dominated by gravelly loam, clay, and decomposed granite. These nutrient-lean soils forcing the roots to dig deep into the bedrock to absorb unique mineral complexities.

Benefiting from a constant, gentle sea breeze that effectively tempers the scorching summer heatwaves, Shandong also enjoys a milder, insulated climate during the colder months. The surrounding ocean acts as a giant thermal heat sink, which prevents the harsh, sub-zero Siberian winters.

This exceptional coastal terroir yields highly elegant, well-structured, and naturally lower-alcohol wines. It carves out a distinct signature style rooted in crisp, saline, mineral-driven Chardonnays and sleek, ocean-influenced red wines, led by Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.

## CHAPTER 2:

# NINGXIA

### Northern Guardians - Continental Power & Structure

Ningxia's iconic wine culture is nestled within the dramatic scenery of the Helan Mountains. Positioned on a high-altitude plateau roughly 1,100 meters above sea level, the region enjoys intensely concentrated sunlight and vast diurnal temperature swings. This unique macroclimate yields exceptionally thick grape skins packed with concentration and structural depth.

The vineyard geology features sandy loam soils, heavily laced with limestone pebbles and gravel washed down from the mountains. These poor, fast-draining soils naturally force vine roots to dig deep, curbing berry size while preserving a bright, vibrant core of natural acidity.

Despite the protection offered by the Helan Mountains against Gobi Desert sandstorms, this desert-style terroir endures an unforgiving climate of hot summers and sub-zero Siberian winters. The freezing winters demand a grueling, labor-intensive ritual: every autumn, viticulturists manually bury their vines under deep earth to insulate them from the frost, unearthing them again each spring.

The resulting wines feature a remarkable, muscular power, deep color, and intense concentration. The region has developed an international reputation for muscular Cabernet Sauvignon, velvety Malbec, and rich, spicy Marselan – China's signature red grape.

## CHAPTER 3:

# YUNNAN

### Mountain Mystics - High Altitude Elegance

Yunnan's ethereal wine culture thrives high above the clouds, hidden within the dizzying, dramatic canyons of the Mekong River and the foothills of the Himalayas. Perched at an astonishing altitude between 1,800 and 2,800 meters, this low-latitude alpine terroir is a landscape of extremes.

Towering mountain peaks cast massive shadows that block the intense afternoon heat, allowing grape skins to develop slowly and preserve a piercing, vibrant core of natural acidity. Vineyards are scattered across tiny, hand-carved mountain terraces rich in multi-hued clay and complex volcanic minerals. This mineral-dense soil forces vine roots into a deep, vertical struggle for nutrients.

Protected from the suffocating humidity of tropical monsoons, the region avoids the grueling northern ritual of winter vine burial entirely. Instead, viticulturists work year-round on vertical slopes, nurturing grapes with pure, high-altitude snow melt. The resulting cool-climate profile offers an unexpected Old-World style marked by perfume, fresh acidity, and fluid grace.

The region has captured global attention for its ultra-premium, hauntingly elegant Cabernet Sauvignon, aromatic Cabernet Franc, and crisp, alpine Chardonnay.

## CHAPTER 4:

# XINJIANG

### Western Frontiers - Ancient Vines & Bold Extremes

Xinjiang's vast viticulture is a philosophy of continental extremism, stretching across an ancient Silk Road landscape of immense desert basins and glacial peaks. Sprawling along the edge of the Tianshan Mountains, this pristine high-desert terroir experiences blazing summer heat and over 3,000 annual hours of raw, unfiltered sunlight. This intense energy yields grapes with exceptionally thick skins, concentrated sugars, and rich, sun-baked phenolics.

The vineyard geology is defined by the rugged Gobi Desert, featuring coarse alluvial gravel mixed with rich carbon deposits carried down by glacial runoff. These highly porous, fast-draining soils naturally stunt berry size while imparting a bold, opulent texture to the fruit. Despite its harshness, the isolated ecosystem remains completely unspoiled by pollution, offering an ultra-clean environment for natural winemaking.

To survive the sub-zero Siberian winters, viticulturists undergo a monumental autumn labor, manually burying entire vineyards deep into the earth before unearthing them every spring.

The wines are unapologetically powerful, boasting ripe tannins, high alcohol, and luscious depth. The region has built an international identity for robust Syrah, concentrated Cabernet Sauvignon, and yet refreshing white wines.

## CHAPTER 5:

# SHANXI & HEBEI

### Northern Reflections - Refined & Experimental

In Shanxi, vineyards thrive on the high-altitude Loess Plateau, perched 800 to 1,200 meters above sea level. Sheltered by the Taihang Mountains, vines are planted in deep, porous yellow silt soils that force roots deep.

The combination of intense sunlight, clean air, and cool nights slows ripening. This unique terroir avoids the heavy, over-ripe profiles of warm regions, yielding wines with striking Old-World elegance, fine-grained tannins, and linear acidity. The region is internationally celebrated for structured Cabernet Sauvignon, silky Merlot, and precise Chardonnay.

To the east, Hebei transitions to a maritime climate influenced by the Bohai Sea and the rugged Yanshan Mountains. This province divides into the historic, sun-drenched Changli coast and the elevated Huailai valley. Grapes grow in weathered granite, gravel, and sandy loam soils that offer excellent drainage and distinct mineral undertones.

Despite summer monsoons, the long growing season develops rich, fleshy fruit weight. To survive brutal winters, viticulturists must perform the grueling annual ritual of burying the vines each autumn. The resulting wines offer a bold balance of ripe fruit and savory complexity, earning global recognition for deep Cabernet Sauvignon, peppery Marselan, and aromatic Syrah.
